

Oshkosh Fastclub 10U League Rules

WIAA rules will apply with the following exceptions:

1. Games are limited to 80 minutes. No inning will start after 75 minutes. Home team records official start time.
2. Pitchers are limited to four innings per game. One pitch will count as an entire inning.
3. There will be no walks. If a batter receives four balls, a coach shall pitch the remaining **amount of strikes**. Girls can be struck out by the pitcher or the coach either swinging or looking. EX: If a girl receives four balls with a count of one strike, she shall get two strikes from the coach, not two pitches, two strikes. Coaches cannot walk batters.
4. No stealing. Runners can advance **one base per batter** on a passed ball or wild pitch. The ball must be past the catcher.
5. Runners can only score on a batted ball.
6. If a batter strikes out and the ball is dropped by the catcher or touches the ground, the batter is out.
7. Players can only play a position for two total innings. No exceptions. This rule does not apply to pitchers or catchers. This is a completely instructional league.
8. Maximum of 10 players on the field. Four players must remain on outfield grass. All players on roster present will bat in lineup. All players must play at least every other inning in the field.
9. Unlimited defensive substitution.
10. Maximum of 4 runs per inning per team.
11. Runners may lead off only after ball has crossed home plate. Players leaving early will be called out.
12. Bunting is allowed only against the player pitcher. No bunting when the coach is pitching.
13. A courtesy runner is allowed for the catcher only. The runner will be the person who made the last out.

14. Sliding is required if a play is being made upon a runner. It is the umpire's judgment as to whether or not a play is being made, and if sliding is necessary. The umpire's decision is final.
15. Scores for the games can be kept, but there will be no league standings that are recorded.

These rules are subject to be adjusted as the season progresses. This is a new division for the club and we can make changes that are necessary to allow the games to be as smooth and fun as possible.

Coaches: The league has divided up the pitchers so that each team has received girls who are taking formal pitching lessons. Any girls interested in pitching should contact the instructors listed on the website. Please use sound judgment and discretion when you put a player on the mound that has little or no training.
